Dear Parent

I have started this series of letters to have a dialogue with you all. As our esteemed partners, your cooperation is of utmost importance that will go in long the way to shape up the future of our children.

We at VVN are committed to the basic cause of bringing up your children and make them proud citizens of FUTURE INDIA.

I would like to draw your attention towards a growing menace of $\underline{\text{Traffic Rules Violation}}$ by school going kids.

As you know that there are some parents who allow their children to go to school on two wheelers (motorcycle, scooty, etc.).

School kids also use bikes and scooty to do some household work or pick and drop someone, even after the school. I want you all to go through the following table showing the information regarding different penalties:

Offence	Penalty
1. Offences by juveniles	 Guardian/owner shall be deemed to be guilty. Rs 25,000 with 3 years' imprisonment and cancellation of the registration of the vehicle for 12 months. Juvenile will be tried under The Juvenile Justice Act.

Dear Parent, the children riding the bikes and scooty fall in this category.

These students:

- (i) Do not have a driving licence.
- (ii) Do not wear helmet.
- (iii) Drive rashly and carelessly on the roads.
- (iv) Carry two or three more students on their bikes on the way to school.
- (v) Drive at a very high speed.
- (vi) Park their vehicles at some places like Dera nearby the school. These places are not safe so there are chances of getting the vehicle stolen.
- (vii) Sometimes these children produce harsh sounds (पटाखा बजाना) also from their bikes, which creates a nuisance on the roads.
- (viii) These students also ride bikes or come by four wheelers to school on special occasions like Annual functions and farewell parties this comes under the category of school indiscipline and violation of traffic rules.

At the end, I would like to remind you all that your children can come to school by any of the following means:

- i) You can drop and pick them yourself.
- ii) They can come on cycles.
- iii) They even can come on foot in case of shorter distance.
- iv) You can use the school transport which is available at an affordable cost.

Please, motivate your child to use cycle for any household work or even coming to school.

I will be grateful if you pay due attention to this problem and help me ensure the safety of your wards. Let us save, secure and nurture our valuable Future of India - our kids.
